WSD AEROSOL SHEEP DRESSING

To Treat and Prevent Flystrike for Sheep

Product Description

WSD AEROSOL SHEEP DRESSING is a treatment and prevention for blowfly strike of sheep.

Type of Preparation

WSD AEROSOL SHEEP DRESSING is an aerosol formulation for topical use containing 25g/Kg dibutyl phthalate and 0.64g/Kg chlorfenvinphos. It is scheduled as a DANGEROUS POISON (S7).

Indications

Sheep and Lambs:

Treatment of blowfly strike. Prevention of blowfly strike of wounds including after mulesing or dehorning.

Milking Sheep: Do NOT use in sheep producing milk for human consumption

Dosage

Always refer to the label. Spray the area thoroughly, including the surrounding skin and wool.

Advice On Use

- The supply of **WSD AEROSOL SHEEP DRESSING** requires an S7 licence or equivalent.
- The product is dangerous and operators should use personal protective equipment.
- Shake the container well before use.
- The wool should be clipped from areas affected by maggots before treatment.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:
RESTRAINTS:**

Do not use on female sheep which are producing or may in the future produce milk or milk products for human consumption.

DOSAGE & ADMINISTRATION:

Shake well before use.
Hold can close to area to be treated and thoroughly spray the struck and surrounding area of skin. To prevent future strike of sheep spray open wounds. Repeat as necessary. All efforts should be made to minimise your exposure to Chlorfenvinphos, particularly the concentrate.

GENERAL DIRECTIONS:

Do not use this product if it is too hot to wear the Personal Protective Equipment (PPE). Not to be used for any purpose, or in any manner, contrary to this label unless authorised under appropriate legislation.

WITHHOLDING PERIODS:

Do not use less than fourteen (14) days before slaughter for human consumption. Do not use on female sheep which are producing or may in the future produce milk or milk products for human consumption.

WOOL HARVEST INTERVAL: DO NOT use less than 1 month before shearing or fibre collection.

TRADE ADVICE:

Use of this product may result in wool residues that may not comply with European Union environmental quality standards. Wool treated with this product may contain detectable residues; adequate treatment records should be kept and made available, if requested by wool buyers.

SAFETY DIRECTIONS:

Product is poisonous if absorbed by skin contact, inhaled or swallowed. Will damage eyes, skin and will irritate the nose and throat. Repeated exposure may cause allergic disorders. Repeated minor exposure may have a cumulative poisoning effect. Obtain a emergency supply of atropine tablets 0.6mg. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. Do not inhale vapour or spray mist. When using the product wear cotton overalls buttoned to the neck and wrist and a washable hat, elbow-length butyl rubber gloves, goggles, impervious footwear and half face piece respirator. If clothing becomes contaminated with product or with wet spray remove clothing immediately. If product or spray gets on skin, immediately wash area with soap and water. If product or spray gets into the eyes, wash it out immediately with water. After use and before eating, drinking or smoking, wash hands, arms and face thoroughly with soap and water. After each day's use wash gloves, goggles, respirator and contaminated clothing. If the items are rubber wash with detergent and warm water.

FIRST AID:

If poisoning occurs, contact a doctor or Poisons Information Centre (Phone 13 11 26). If swallowed give one atropine tablet every 15 minutes until dryness of the mouth occurs – if poisoned by skin absorption or through lungs, remove any contaminated clothing, wash skin thoroughly and give atropine tablets as above. Get to a doctor or hospital quickly.

ADDITIONAL USER SAFETY:

Sheep Rehandling Interval: Two weeks. If sheep must be handled during this interval, cotton overalls buttoned to the neck (or equivalent clothing) should be worn. Material Safety Data Sheet: Additional information is listed in the Material Safety Data Sheet, which can be obtained from the supplier.

ENVIRONMENTAL STATEMENTS:

Dangerous to wildlife and fish. Do not use this product in a manner which causes the product or used containers to enter streams, rivers and waterways.

DISPOSAL:

Aerosols should be completely empty before disposal. Place used cans in household rubbish. Do not puncture or incinerate this can even when empty.

STORAGE:

Store in a locked room or place away from children, animals, food, feedstuffs, seed and fertiliser.
Store below 30°C (room temperature) in the closed, original container in a dry, well-ventilated area and protect from light.
